1. (3 points) Compute $\frac{d}{dx} \left[2x^2 + 9x - 6x^{-\frac{4}{3}} \right]$. Solution: $8x^{-\frac{7}{3}} + 4x + 9$

⁶ **2.** (3 points) Compute using the quotient rule: $\frac{d}{dx} \left[\frac{5x^2}{\sqrt[4]{x}} \right]$. Solution: Compute

$$\frac{d}{dx} \left[\frac{5x^2}{\sqrt[4]{x}} \right] = \frac{x^{\frac{1}{4}}(10x) - \frac{5}{4}x^2x^{-\frac{3}{4}}}{x^{\frac{1}{2}}}$$

3. (4 points) Compute using the product rule: $\frac{d}{dx} [(7x + \sqrt[4]{x})(\sqrt[3]{x} + \sqrt[5]{x} + 1)].$ Solution: Compute

$$\frac{d}{dx} \left[(7x + \sqrt[4]{x}) \left(\sqrt[3]{x} + \sqrt[5]{x} + 1 \right) \right] \\= \left(7 + \frac{1}{4}x^{-\frac{3}{4}} \right) \left(\sqrt[3]{x} + \sqrt[5]{x} + 1 \right) + \left(\frac{1}{3}x^{-\frac{2}{3}} + \frac{1}{5}x^{-\frac{4}{5}} \right) \left(7x + x^{\frac{1}{4}} \right).$$
