

R & RSTUDIO INSTALLATION GUIDE

Using Fairmont's Online Version:

- (1) log into a **wired** campus computer and go to the URL <http://10.253.49.9:8787/>. To log in, use the credentials provided to you by your instructor.

Installation on your PC:

- (1) You will first need a working version of R installed on your computer.

- (a) You can find the software at:

<https://ftp.ussg.iu.edu/CRAN/>

This is one specific mirror at Indiana University. There are many others available if you have trouble with this one. You can find them by googling "CRAN mirrors".

- (b) Choose the version corresponding to your operating system, download and install.
 - (i) You do NOT have to actually run R when you work in RStudio. However, RStudio does need the underlying software in order to work.
 - (ii) It's a good idea to use the default file location. RStudio will need to find the location in the next step.

- (2) Next, you will need RStudio.

- (a) The software is located here:

- (b) Again, select the version you need for your OS, download and install.
 - (c) If you have installed R already, then when you start up RStudio it should auto-detect the location of R and you should be good to go.
 - (i) If you created a custom file location for R, you may need to tell RStudio where that is the first time you start.
